- 1 – Meeting minutes for last month were approved.
- 2 – Discussion about tree in front of Town Hall – if it's taken down, don't replace it. Marc indicated he can't decorate it any more (can't get a bucket truck in there).
- 3 – Bill was received for brochures – about \$2200. Ginger also bought lights for the tree which cost about \$150.
- 4 - Marc indicated he might be gone during the 1st week of December – could pose a problem with tree set-up, decoration, etc.
- 5 - Lou Schuller & Faith Minton spoke about their group called Warner Connects which started because of the need to re-connect people with people because today, people's lives are too busy. They hold monthly meetings, usually one Sunday night each month at 7 p.m., and hold pot luck dinners, contra dances, game nights at White Mountain Coffee, craft night, and other things that don't cost a lot of money. - 10- Chris Daniels advised that the decorating preparations are all set – fluffing on Friday, Dec. 1, followed by decorating Town Hall on Saturday, Dec. 2.
- 11- Ginger advised more donations for door prizes are needed – she will make some additional calls --- everyone try to help out.
