- 1 - Meeting minutes for June were approved.
- 2 - Treasurer's report was given to Marc by Ginger Marsh (not in attendance) and includes the year-to-date. Motion was made to approve the report subject to clarification/explanation.
- 3 - It was agreed Sect. 4, p. 2 of the new by-laws would now read "notified" and Article 8 on p. 10 would have the parentheses removed around "policy". Motion was made to approve the by-laws – all were in favor.
- 4 – Festival of Trees meeting was held on July 1. It was determined that tree set up would be the day after Thanksgiving at 5 p.m. Trees will be kept up until a few days after Christmas. Tickets will continue to be \$10 each and attendance will continue to be adults only. - 8 – Marc announced he believes there are upcoming changes in zoning that would be less restrictive and would promote economic growth. We (the Chamber) should help advocate.
