- 1 – Meeting minutes from April were reviewed, and motion was made to approve. All were in favor.
- 2 - Cheryl Blais spoke about the Business after Hours event held last week at The Maples which had a good turnout but, despite the amount of invitations that went out to the various towns, most of those that attended were from Warner businesses.
- 3 – By-laws need to be checked concerning whether or not a business that offers to host a Business after Hours event has to be a member of the KACC (due to the fact that their business is being promoted).
- 4 - Rhonda Rood will call All Signs about obtaining a banner that can be used for KACC sponsored events.
- 5 - Cindy provided us with the Treasurer's Report. The beautification and brochure acct. balances are the same. Motion was made to approve the report and all were in favor.
- 6 - Maryann will speak with those in charge of the upcoming 4<sup>th</sup> of July events in Bradford to see if they would like any assistance or sponsorship from the KACC.
- 7 - Colby Real Estate gave away an Ipod during the Spring Into Warner event on March 15. The winner was from Wilmot.
- 8 - The Battle of the Bands at the Spring Into Warner event was attended by approx. 300 people. The bands were great! On a side note, Laura Buono reminded us that anyone wanting to use a town building or area must complete a Use Form and obtain the town's permission.
- 9 - Committee reports:
