- 1 - The Festival of Trees date was determined to be Saturday, December 8.
- 2 - Ginger advised that 2 more membership dues were received since last month. Marc Violette will be sending out bills now as he believes he may not have sent them out previously.
- 3 - Laura Buono, Town Administrator, brought us up to date on Town news since last meeting:
 - the budget season is finished
 - the Water Precinct article passed
 - the traffic light did not pass
 - there was an amendment by the Board to give \$12,500 towards the wage scales at the Transfer Station, if needed
 - Laura attended a workshop on junkyards, and advised that 2 or more unregistered vehicles on someone's property is, technically, considered a junkyard
- 4 - Chris Daniels attended the Capital Area Public Health Network Training Meeting on March 14 and advised that more volunteers are needed. If interested, call Wendy Dumas @ 230-6162 or email her @ wdumais@crhc.org.
- 5 - Barbara Annis brought us up to date on the Planning Board meetings:
 - apparently there was some mis-information at last night's meeting and some people were called and told to vote "no" on #9
 - it was realized that too many people vote "no" right down the line
 - large number of people from City for Smart Growth applying to become members of the Planning Board (Laura Buono advised she knows the Planning Board is looking for some diversity)
 - one more meeting is needed for RAW - may get their approval soon. They will be putting in their own pumping station.
 - Begin Construction will be putting in his own pumping station too
 - RAW and Begin Construction will be required to put in two turning lanes to make certain there is always access for emergency vehicles
 - the Wagner subdivision has encountered some problems in that they were made to revise their plans many times. Now there will be a round table discussion at a public forum.
