- 1 - Discussed having a "welcome back" party in September.
- 2 - Ginger advised the approval was given for Sugar River Savings Bank's expansion.
- 3 - Marc spoke about the Kearsarge Community Center which is a newly formed entity. He is on a committee with members from all 7 towns within the school district. It's located at the old high school portion of the middle school. A portion of the building will be used by the Outing Club. The old side will be renovated and will have a fire wall separating the Community Center and the Outing Club. They (KCC) need to raise \$2.5 million to do this, and the lease will be signed soon.
- 4 - Marc also advised that the Riverside Park Fields were ruined and the baseball and softball teams couldn't use the fields for a good portion of the season. Laura Buono advised that a person was hired to maintain the fields.
- 5 - Laura Buono gave us an update on town matters:
 - more sand is needed at the beach....it's a process that may take until next year to accomplish.
 - FEMA is working with the town (Ed Mical, Alan Brown).
 - the CIP (Capital Improvement Program) was started.
 - trying to speed up the budget process so it is done by Christmas. Laura will be meeting with the Department heads in July to get this on its way.
 - still looking for a replacement for the Planning Board Secretary (26 hrs. position)
 - the new highway foreman is Brad Kelly
 - there is a meeting on July 2 with Tom Brennan, Supt. of KRSD, about the drainage problem at the elementary school (will the school district help to take care of the drainage situation?)
 - the 1st municipal audit will be conducted soon
- 6 - The museum is moving out of the old Perkins Hardware building and going back to where they were, per Barbara Maki.
