Just need WiFi? Our "publicuse" WiFi reaches out to the parking area and also into the Jim Mitchell Park.

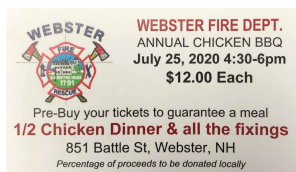
Warner Area Farmer's Market Saturdays 9 am -1 pm
